MEETING MINUTES

The regular public meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1E was held virtually on Wednesday, April 22, 2026. Chair Josh Jacobson called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. ET. Secretary Brad Howard was temporarily absent at the start of the meeting. At the Chair's request, Vice Chair Audra Grant called the roll.

A quorum was present, with four of seven current Commissioners present at the time of the roll call.

Notice of the meeting was provided through community listservs, social media, the ANC 1E website, and eCalendar.

The agenda was adopted without objection.

Commissioners Brad Howard (1E01) and Philippa Hawker (1E03) joined after the agenda was adopted and before the recorded vote on the consent agenda.

On motion of Commissioner Audra Grant, the consent agenda was adopted, 6-0-0, and , consisted of:

- Meeting minutes of the Regular Public Meeting on March 25, 2026; and,
- Approval of the ANC 1E Quarterly Financial Report for FY26 Q1.

The Commission received a presentation from Councilmember Brianne Nadeau. The Commission also received a public-safety and community update from Enrique Lopez of the Mayor's Office of Community Relations and Services.

The Commission received officer and committee updates, including an announcement that Commissioner Philip Newland (1E05) would be vacating his seat soon due to moving outside the ANC.

The proposed resolution regarding the District's rodent fertility-control pilot was withdrawn by Commissioner Howard, and no action was taken.

On motion of Commissioner Brad Howard, Resolution #1E-2026-0401, Providing for the Consideration of Improvements to the Park View Neighborhood Sign and Beautification of Its Surrounding Public Space, was adopted, 6-0-0.

On motion of Commissioner Brad Howard, Resolution #1E-2026-0402, Directing the Formal Exploration of Erecting a Second Park View Neighborhood Sign, was adopted, 6-0-0.

The Chair announced that the next regular public meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, May 27, 2026, virtually at 7:00 p.m. ET.

On motion of Commissioner Brian Footer, the meeting adjourned at 8:21 p.m. ET, 6-0-0.
