MINUTES OF THE REGULAR PUBLIC MEETING ON JUNE 24, 2026

MEETING MINUTES

The regular public meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1E was held virtually on Wednesday, June 24, 2026, at 7:03 p.m., Chair Josh Jacobson being in the chair and Secretary Brad Howard being present. The meeting was noticed to the community via listserv, social media, website, and e-calendar.

A quorum was present, with four of six current Commissioners present at the time of the roll call.

On motion of Commissioner Hawker, the agenda was adopted without objection, with Commissioner Howard withdrawing his engagement strategy resolution from the proposed agenda.

On motion of Commissioner Howard, the Consent Agenda was adopted without objection. The Consent Agenda included Approval of the Minutes of ANC 1E's Regular Public Meeting, May 2026.

The Chair recognized scheduled guests, Commissioners, and the public for community announcements. The following presentations were made:

- Eliza-Roche Robinson, Office of Councilmember Brianne Nadeau, provided an update on the District budget, including Ward 1 and ANC 1E investments, and announced upcoming Ward 1 events. Ms. Robinson stated that the Councilmember's office would provide the date and location for a future Brianne on Your Block event when set.
- Enrique López, Mayor's Office of Community Relations and Services, provided updates on illegal dumping response procedures and 311 service-request escalation. Commissioner Grant requested follow-up regarding Warder Street NW and Park Road NW. Mr. López stated that EOM would follow up regarding the 311 outage and communicate updates to ANCs.
- Chair Jacobson reported on 311 app reliability concerns and a crowdsourced pool and splash pad status tool. Chair Jacobson stated that he would circulate flyers for Commissioners and community members to post.
- Resident Paola Barahona appeared regarding parking restrictions and the loss of parking spaces on the 800 block of Otis Place NW. Commissioner Hawker stated that she would review prior ANC correspondence and follow up with DDOT.

The Secretary's report was received and filed.

The Secretary reported that Commissioner Philip Newland had submitted his resignation, that the 1E05 seat was vacant, and that the vacancy would be filled in the November election.

The Secretary further reported that the following correspondence and reports had been received and filed as appendices to these minutes:

The report of the Transportation and Public Space Committee was received. Commissioner Howard stated that he would circulate the prior ANC 1A Park View sign history study and include in the minutes (See Appendix E). The next Transportation and Public Space

Committee meeting was announced for Wednesday, July 1, 2026, at 7:00 p.m., at Rock Creek Church Road NW and Park Place NW.

No report was received for the Public Safety and Engagement Committee was received. The next Public Safety and Engagement Committee meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 8, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.

The report of the Zoning and Economic Development Committee concerning BZA Case No. 21405 was received. The next Zoning and Economic Development Committee meeting was announced for Wednesday, July 8, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.

On motion of Commissioner Hawker, Resolution #1E-2026-100, “Consideration of Committee Recommendation to Reaffirm ANC 1E’s Prior Support for BZA Case No. 21405 and Authorize Filing of a New ANC Report in Support of the Revised Plan,” was approved without objection.

The report of the Georgia Avenue Economic Development Special Committee was received. Chair Jacobson reported that Councilmember Nadeau had secured \$400,000 in the District budget for Georgia Avenue and stated that he would provide proposed spending language. Commissioners were asked to provide suggestions for use of the funds. The next Georgia Avenue Economic Development Special Committee meeting was announced for Monday, June 29, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.

There was no unfinished business.

On motion of Commissioner Howard, Resolution #1E-2026-101, “Approving a Grant to Wangari Gardens for Benches and a Picnic Table,” authored by Commissioner Hawker, was

adopted 4-0-0.

Commissioner Howard withdrew his draft resolution, “Providing Comments to the District of Columbia Housing Authority on the Draft FY2027 Moving to Work Annual Plan.” No action was taken.

On motion of Commissioner Hawker, Resolution #1E-2026-102, “Requesting Council to Ban Blocking Bike Lanes in the Autonomous Vehicle Deployment Authorization Amendment Act of 2026,” authored by Commissioner Jacobson, was adopted 4-0-0.

On motion of Commissioner Howard, Resolution #1E-2026-103, “Requesting Mayor to Not Block Rideshare and Micromobility Services in Juvenile Curfew Zones,” authored by Commissioner Jacobson, was adopted 4-0-0.

On motion of Commissioner Howard, Resolution #1E-2026-104, “Establishing the Park View Recreation Center Construction Accountability and Resident Engagement (CARE) Task Force,” authored by Commissioner Howard, was adopted 4-0-0.

By unanimous consent, the Commission amended the adopted agenda to add consideration of a motion by Commissioner Howard regarding constituent engagement under New Business.

Commissioner Howard moved that ANC 1E authorize a printed mail piece to households within the Commission area to promote public participation, resident engagement, newsletter subscriptions, GovDelivery sign-ups, and committee participation; authorize expenditures for that public purpose in an amount not to exceed \$3,500; and delegate implementation to the Executive Committee, including approval of the final mailer design, vendor selection, mailing method, and timeline, subject to ANC 1E financial procedures. The motion was adopted by a

vote of 4-0-0.

Chair Jacobson announced that ANC 1E's next regular public meeting would be held virtually on Wednesday, July 22, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting adjourned without objection at approximately 8:59 p.m.
